The application period for the fall semester and full academic year 2021-2022 at FIB-UPC is already open.

We are confident that next academic year we will be able to start the way back to normality.

Once the application is closed by the students the coordinator of your institution (his/her e-mail is provided by the students in the application form) and the person who did the nomination will receive an e-mail in order to validate the information provided in the application form.

Once your students are finally accepted, they will be able to download the acceptance letter and the learning agreement through the mobility platform. Besides that, approximately 3 or 4 weeks after the end of their stay you will able to download their transcript of records.
